- Acted for V Capital (a member of the Vanke Property Group) in drafting and negotiating a joint venture with LKK Health Products Group Limited for the purpose of making the RMB 5.7 billion purchase of the holding company owning 99% of the Corporate Avenue 3 Property in Shanghai, PRC.
